

he demand for health care information technology is nearly endless. However, that demand must be balanced within an organization's economic realities and its ability to absorb change. The desire by senior leadership to remain abreast of important new information technologies, while gaining the most from those already committed, is a challenge that causes many health care organizations to employ a Chief Information Officer
